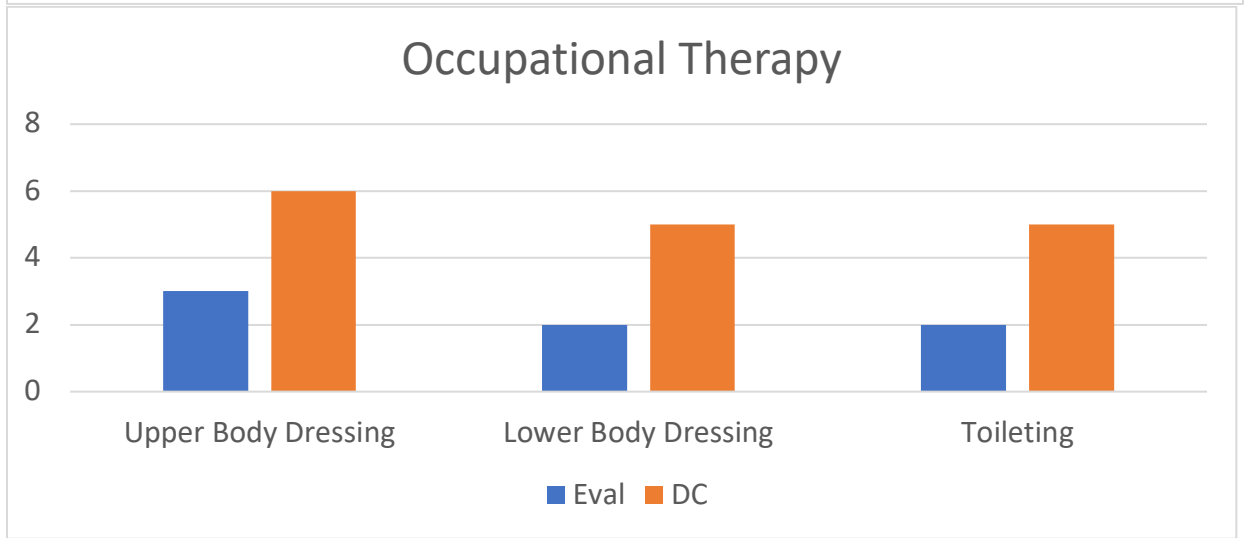
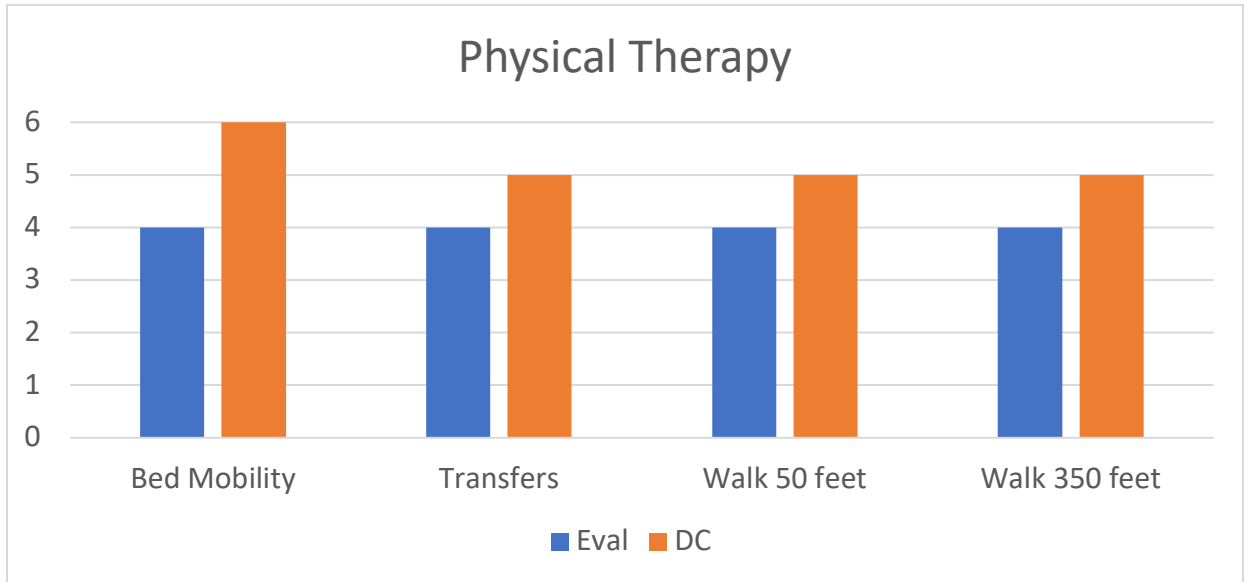




Ronald Townsend is an 89-year-old male who was hospitalized at Memorial Hermon Northeast for Covid-19. Mr. Townsend has a medical history of a brain tumor, Parkinsons disease and A fib. During his hospital stay he stated showing decrease in strength, balance, and poor endurance. He was treated for his conditions and discharged to Deerbrook Skilled Nursing and Rehab on 7/25/2024.

On 7/26/2024, Mr. Townsend was evaluated by Occupational Therapy. The initial assessment indicated that he required maximal assistance for lower body dressing and toileting. He also required moderate assistance for upper body dressing. The Physical Therapy assessment indicated that he required minimal assistance for bed mobility and transfers. He also ambulated 50 feet minimal assistance using a two wheeled walker. Both PT and OT created individualized plans of care to help Mr. Townsend improve his mobility and activities of daily living for the following 21 days of skilled therapy.

Upon discharge. Mr. Townsend demonstrated significant improvements in his functional mobility and ability to perform activities of daily living. He improved his bed mobility to Modified Independence and transfers to Supervision. He is also able to ambulate 350 feet at supervision level, using a four wheeled walker. He improved his self-care skills, requiring modified independent for upper body dressing. He also improved his lower body dressing and toileting to Supervision level. With improved mobility and requiring less physical assistance. Ronald Townsend was able to discharge home with family on 8/24/2024.



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05 - Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to

complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
