

OUTCOMES MATTER

Patient: J. White

Length of Stay: 10 Days

Facility: Deerbrook Skilled Nursing & Rehab

AT DISCHARGE:

Following a 10-day stay of skilled nursing and therapy services, Mrs. White made significant gains with physical therapy by achieving her goal walking 50 plus feet at Modified Independence. Additionally, she made gains and now completes transfers at Modified Independence. Toileting tasks and dressing she completes with stand by assistance.

Sweet Mrs. White was successfully discharged with family independently.

ADMISSION & TREATMENT:

Joella White is a 93-year-old female who was admitted to Deerbrook SNF on 12/19/24 and discharged back home on 1/2/25. She was hospitalized at Memorial Herman Northeast due to hypoxic respiratory failure and was found to have influenza A.

The Therapy team at Deerbrook evaluated Mrs. White the following day. She required minimal assistance for bed mobility, transfers, and upper body dressing. Maximal assistance for lower body dressing. She was also walking 20feet at minimal assistance. Her goal was to return home and be independent again. The rehab team at Deerbrook SNF helped make that dream a reality.
